At the end of the month of January we had a group of volunteers coming to do a deep cleaning before the students arrived and to set some safety covid-19 rules. We all were so excited! Finally the date came, February 3rd, and we opened for the students. We were so happy to see the first 6 students coming, the next week we saw 6 more students coming, and at the very end of the month of March we received the last student coming to finish his last year of training. We




are so happy to have 13 students, 12 first year students and one 3rd year. But at the same time, we are a little sad because Vidal, one of our students, had to go back home because of illness. Please pray for him - his case is difficult, because he has had kidney stones since last year. His spleen is swollen, and now he needs to have treatments. We

also have another student that, after 4 months, decided to go home for personal reasons. Right now, we have a total of 11 students on campus.

As I see these 11 young men getting training, I am also praying for 11 faithful pastors in the near future. It is amazing that 10 of them are in their first year, and all of them are already preaching during the weekends. Three of them are already involved in the role as pastor because of the hard situation in their churches that are right now without a pastor. The highlight of these past months is so marvelous: "God is using the lives of these young men as they share the Word of God. During the

weekend's student ministry, 29 people have come to know Christ as their personal Savior and 20 people have rededicated their lives to the Lord'.

Another good news is, in the month of May we also started the module program for those that are not able to come to the Bible Institute campus. The module program is for 2 years of study, and it is developed in a particular church for students from our churches that are in the same area. Right now, we have 3 groups, and usually we hold one module in our Bible Institute campus. We have enrolled a total of 26 students right



now and hoping to have more as we continue seeking God's guidance each day and covid-19 slows down.
